

Multilex Bulletin – August 2019

The Multilex Bulletin is an indication of notable changes made to the Multilex database. It also provides general information and advance warnings of changes for future months. Changes to product name are expressed in the form of the Multilex Preferred Display Name. Customers using other naming conventions may not see the changes as listed. Visibility of changes is dependent on the current data being loaded into your system and the specified element being available via your interface.

Dm+d/Manufacturer Changes

The following products have been amended in line with the Dictionary of Medicines and Devices (dm+d) and/or the manufacturers' Summary of Product Characteristics (SPC):

Asenapine sublingual tablets

Asenapine sublingual tablets now reads: Asenapine sublingual tablets sugar-free

Dermol wash

Dermol wash now reads: Dermal Wash cutaneous emulsion

Drug Tariff Changes

The following products have been amended/updated in line with the August 2019 England and Wales Drug Tariff:

All Silicone catheters (LINC Medical Systems)

Some products in the All Silicone catheters (LINC Medical Systems) range now read: LINC All Silicone

Tricitrates oral solution (new addition to Part VIIIB)

Tricitrates is represented on Multilex by the generic 'citric acid 334/5ml and potassium citrate 550mg/5ml and sodium citrate 500mg/5ml', in line with dm+d.

Consequently, the Drug Tariff price and code has been added to the Multilex generic.
